- Linda Payant – City Rep – information
  - Provided map of the East end to show future plans that the City has for By-pass and Transit route – **ACTION** to get a large one for association
  - Handout of Frequently Ask Questions for Food Safety and Special Events-Health Protection and Promotion Act – churches, Lions etc will only be investigated if complaints received – tips to cook on-site whenever possible – bake sales are not problem
  - Civic Appreciation Awards close on March 31 – see website for required info
  - Reneau Road is due to be open on March 31 – general concern with all roads due to mild winter and construction traffic but not much \$ available and on-going construction will delay final surfacing and intersection at Trim and Innes.
  - City has approved \$ for community signage – they are aware of ours but we may be able to get some funding for refurbishing.
  - Sidewalks on Smith Road – study shows that not enough space to put a sidewalk – summary to come
  - Human Rights Office has excess paint available for free – call 594-9466 if anyone wants any.
  - Innes Road should be completed by July
  - Ottawa landfill Watch is keeping a close eye on the Carp dump – there is a quota required for the dump each day and if not met then outside companies sometimes get to use it [www.ottawalandfillwatch.org](http://www.ottawalandfillwatch.org)
  - Summer Jobs for ages 14-24 for the City are posted – **ACTION** will include on our website
