5.10 Park Plan – Emmanuelle Grandmaitre

Emmanuelle reported the package went out to contractors and there will be a meeting tomorrow to see what we can do with the funding we have on hand. She also reported that the City has agreed to install both the junior and senior playstructures this year. After reviewing several prices it was decided that the new landscape architect would be Jeff Kaster(?) Whose price was lower than two other contractors. He was also familiar with our project. When work commences trucks will be entering the park through Wickham and it was felt letters should be sent to residents being affected by this activity. Emmanuelle will take care of this.

5.12 <u>Cenotaph Project – Ross Bradley</u>

Ross was pleased to announce that \$70,000.00 has been raised thus far towards the project. This does not include the expected monies from the Department of Veterans Affairs of \$25,000.00. The entire project will cost around \$140,000.00
